

INTERNATIONAL CENSUS REVIEW TEAM—2012 CENSUS

This activity report of the International Census Review Team covers the period from Monday 9 September 2013 through Friday 13 September 2013. A brief description of our activities is presented below.

The week started with a field trip to regional office, Antofagasta. We visited 4 census sectors two of which were in mining area and other two were in difficult to enumerate areas. We obtained significant information regarding field operations in the regional office. We reviewed some of their control forms which were very informative.

We reviewed the census legal requirements that INE provided us. We asked for additional information regarding the legal mandate of the census. This information would have helped determine the primary objective of our mission. However, later during the week, a meeting with Dr. Coeymans and his staff clarified objectives of our mission. During the meeting, his staff made several presentations and asked us to provide INE recommendations/guidance on number of issues as objective of our mission.

We also met with Felipe Zamorano and Isabel Millan, members of the External Commission, to get information related to their report.

We met with the previous director of the INE who discussed his analysis of the census results using a number *comuna*.

We also had a brief meeting with the Minister of the Ministry of Economics.

We had skype conference with Roberto bianchini to update him with our activities.

We had a concluding meeting of the discovery phase with the Dr. Coeymans.
